- Honor and Remember Nebraska Chapter is entry #31. Lineup begins at 5 pm on Jones St., between 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup>. Arrive no later than 6 pm. Parking available in the lower level of the Durham Museum parking lot. Shuttle to parade lineup location available.
- Grammy Award winning artist, **LEE GREENWOOD**, will begin the parade by singing the National Anthem
- The 6-block parade will end at the Durham Museum where the concert will be held following the parade
- Leading the parade will be a riderless black horse & over 100 Gold Star family members from 10 states. Other entries include Fort Riley soldiers riding in the 1871 Army Escort Wagon & the world-renowned Budweiser Clydesdales



- The Patriotic Concert will include: Lee Greenwood singing "God Bless the USA," Camille Metoyer Moten performing "American Anthem," the Omaha Symphonic Chorus and Grateful Heart singing selections of patriotic music.
